

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

This product raises the pH of swimming pool water. The proper range is 7.2 - 7.8. This range will allow your sanitizer to: work more effectively, reduce equipment corrosion, reduce eye irritation and reduce skin dryness.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read entire label and use in accordance with precautionary statements and directions.

Before Adding this product to Your Pool:

1. Measure the pH of the pool water with a reliable test kit or test strip.
2. If pH is below 7.2, add this product at the rate of 1 lb per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

How to Add this product to Your Pool:

1. Broadcast this product over the entire pool surface.
2. Keep the circulation pump running.
3. Retest the pH level after 4 hours.
4. Repeat treatment as necessary until pH is in the acceptable range of 7.2 to 7.8 (ideal pH is 7.4 to 7.6).

How to Prevent pH Variations or Buffering:

1. Keep the total alkalinity between 60 - 120 parts per million (ppm).
2. Test alkalinity every 2 weeks with a reliable test kit or test strip.

To Determine Pool Capacity in U.S. Gallons:

Rectangular-Multiply length (ft.) x width (ft.) x average depth (ft.) x 7.5

Round-Multiply diameter (ft.) x diameter (ft.) x average depth (ft.) x 5.9

Oval-Multiply long diameter (ft.) x short diameter (ft.) x average depth (ft.) x 5.9

FIRST AID:

If Swallowed

- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If in Eyes

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on Skin or Clothing

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Inhaled

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
- Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Keep this product dry in original, tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry place. Spills should be rinsed with plenty of water.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container with water then place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
